

MEET MOLLY



Molly has been living with anorexia for over 10 years, having first been diagnosed aged 19.

She secretly battled with the eating disorder whilst in school, leaving a negative impact on her mental health.

Molly reached out to The King's Trust who suggested the Enterprise programme as they saw potential in her crafting, a creative hobby that Molly picked as a child.

She gained funding and support to further develop her business.

The Trust played a part in saving my life and allowing me to become who I am today.



How Your Money Fundraising Helps!

£20 - Provide a young person with work experience

£50 – Cover a month's travel costs for a young person to unlock new opportunities

£100 – Could go towards specialist equipment for a lifelong career for a young person

£500 – Could support 10 young people to travel to their new job before their first pay cheque

£5000 - Could support a Get Hired event for 30 young people
