In March 2023, we announced the launch of the Million Makers Alumni Network, an exclusive network for previous Million Makers participants to continue their involvement with Million Makers and The King's Trust. We want the Alumni Network to provide opportunities that enable you to continue developing professionally and personally and have an impact on the young people we support.

WHAT DOES THE ROLE INVOLVE?

We need you to utilise your own Million Makers experience, to encourage a Million Makers team throughout the challenge, as and when they need a bit of support.

The role may involve:



Providing advice on business planning and pitching



Using your previous experience to advise the team on how to overcome internal barriers



Be a coach to team members who are struggling, and remind team members of the personal and professional benefits as they face challenges



Making suggestions on fundraising initiatives to grow profit, based on your previous success

This role is flexible and it's up to you and the team to decide on ways of working. You might set expectations on how often you connect, how they contact you or what type of support is needed.

WHAT SKILLS WILL I NEED AND WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE?

You don't need to have prior mentoring experience to be an Alumni Mentor. This is an opportunity for you to develop your own skill set.
